USAV and Moku O Keawe are committed to offering a safe competitive environment, and to protecting the mental and physical health of our participants. We are actively engaged in the US SafeSport program and are strict adherents to its principles. Every adult over the age of eighteen working with MOK-USAV junior players must be cleared through a comprehensive background check and must be SafeSport Certified annually. ***The MOK registers and certifies participants solely under the auspices of USA-Volleyball and offers all its competitions in full compliance with all USAV doctrines and regulations.*** The MOK recognizes and adopts (for purposes of RVA activities and privileges) any penalties imposed by the USA Volleyball Ethics & Eligibility Committee.

As a member of USAV, the Region has adopted USAV's mission statement and goals. The Executive Committee/Board of Directors of the Region has committed its efforts to the maintenance of the mission statement and achievement of its goals.
